In the Diary of St. Faustina, Jesus Christ made a special promise:

My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners.

I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My Mercy (Diary, 699).

In addition Our Lord says:

I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My mercy (1109).

"Yes, the first Sunday after Easter is the Feast of Mercy, but there must also be acts of mercy" (742).

"The graces of My mercy are drawn by means of one vessel only, and that is trust. The more a soul trusts, the more it will receive" (1578).

Whoever approaches the Fount of Life on this day will be granted complete forgiveness of sins and punishment (300).

How to Prepare

- 1. Celebrate the Feast April 27th
- 2. Sincerely repent of all our sins
- 3. Completely trust in Jesus
- 4. Go to Confession
- 5. Receive Holy Communion on the day of the Feast.
- 6. Venerate the Image of The Divine Mercy
- 7. Be merciful to others through action, words, and prayers
